

ORDINANCE NO. 22 -70

To authorize the Mayor, to execute a contract with The Board of Education of Bexley for the construction of one modified Dynacote tennis court, ~~and to declare an emergency.~~

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor, on behalf of the City of Bexley, Ohio, be and he hereby is authorized and directed to execute an agreement with The Board of Education of Bexley, which shall contain provisions that the City of Bexley agrees to pay for one all weather tennis court with modified Dynacote elastomeric surfacing to be constructed in connection with other tennis courts and an all weather 1/4 mile track being constructed on the grounds owned by The Board of Education of Bexley at 250-348 South Cassingham Road, the cost of which will be \$6,155.00, the contract to contain such other covenants and conditions as may be acceptable to both parties with regard to use of the court by the residents of Bexley, the maintenance of the court and other relevant matters.

Section 2. That the sum of \$6,155.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund for the purpose aforesaid.

Section 3. That this ordinance ^{shall take EFFECT AND BE IN FORCE} ~~is an emergency measure necessary~~ for the ~~immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that the Board of Education is ready to sign the contract for the construction of said courts and track but cannot do so until the agreement with the City of Bexley has been executed, and this ordinance shall go into force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor,~~ FROM AND AFTER THE EARLIEST PERIOD ALLOWED BY LAW.
