

ORDINANCE NO. 24 -70

Providing for the purchase of two automobiles for the use of the Department of Public Safety, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be, and they are hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase of two 1971 model 4 door sedans, standard size Sedans, complete with standard equipment; the wheelbase of each shall be at least 117 inches; the engine shall be not less than 300 cu. in. eight cylinder (V-8) gasoline powered unit of not less than 210 horsepower; there shall be automatic transmission; heavy duty special police lining brakes; standard equipment wheels and tires; the electrical system shall include roof light wiring and spot light, outside left side; alternator, 42 amp., minimum; backup lights; battery, heavy duty - 70 amp. minimum; hazard warning system; horn; windshield wipers and washer; the color Silver - to be selected by the City of Bexley; there shall be heavy duty police suspension; no-slip differential; heavy duty seat; arm rests (right and left); cooling - high capacity radiator; electric trunk lock; heaters and defrosters; mirror (remote interior and outside left); padded dash; reinforcement on roof for flasher; seat belts; speedometer - certified calibrated - with stop; power steering; not to exceed \$3,000.00 each in cost, the delivery date to be stated in the bid and to be taken into consideration in awarding the contract. Each bid may also include optional bids for bucket seats, split bench seats and/or air conditioning, which the Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to include in the contract if it seems advisable to do so.

Section 2. Said contract shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law. The sum of \$6,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund for the purpose aforesaid.

Section 3. This ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that the said Police Department is in need of said automobiles for patrol duty, and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
