

ORDINANCE NO. 26 -70

To require all bicycles to be licensed.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. No person, who resides within this city, shall ride or propel a bicycle on any street or sidewalk, or on public property, unless such bicycle has been licensed and a Bexley license plate decal attached thereto. New residents shall have a grace period of thirty (30) days.

Section 2. Application for a bicycle license and license plate decal shall be made on a form provided by the city and shall be made to an officer of the Police Department. A fee of One Dollar (\$1.00) shall be paid to the city before such license is issued.

Section 3. (a). Any officer of the Police Department, upon receiving proper application therefor, is authorized to issue a bicycle license, which shall be effective until the next transfer of ownership of the bicycle.

(b) No officer shall issue a license for any bicycle when he knows or has reasonable ground to believe that the applicant is not the owner or entitled to possession of such bicycle.

(c) The Police Department shall keep a record of the number of each license, the date issued, the name and address of the person to whom issued, the description of the bicycle and the number on the frame, if any, and a record of all license fees collected.

Section 4. (a). The officer, upon issuing a bicycle license, shall also issue a license plate decal bearing the number assigned to the bicycle and the name of the city.

(b) The officer or the owner shall cause such license plate decal to be firmly applied to the rear mudguard or frame of the bicycle for which issued, in such a position as to be plainly visible from the rear.

(c) No person shall remove a license plate decal from a bicycle except upon transfer of ownership or in the event the bicycle is permanently dismantled.

(d) Any person who is the owner of a licensed bicycle and changes his residence within the city, must notify the Police Department the location of his new residence, and the number of his license plate decal.

Section 5. Upon the sale or other transfer of the ownership of a licensed bicycle, the licensee shall remove the license plate decal.

Section 6. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not to exceed Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars, and shall pay the costs of prosecution.

Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
