

ORDINANCE NO. 30 -70

To provide for the creation of the positions of Superintendent of Water Lines and Service, Assistant Superintendent of Streets and Assistant Superintendent of Service, to establish salaries for the same and for the Superintendent of Parks, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the positions of Superintendent of Water Lines and Service, Assistant Superintendent of Streets, Assistant Superintendent of Service are hereby created as of October 1, 1970, the duties, responsibility and authority of each of said positions to be determined and designated by the Mayor, and to be subject to amendment by the Mayor whenever he shall deem it necessary.

Section 2. That the yearly salaries of each of said positions shall be determined by the Mayor within the ranges established by this ordinance and shall be paid every two weeks:

	<u>Minimum</u>	<u>Maximum</u>
(a) Superintendent of Water Lines and Service (payable 50% out of Water Fund and 50% out of Sewer Fund)	\$7,100.00	\$7,500.00
(b) Assistant Superintendent of Streets (payable out of the Street Fund)	\$7,500.00	\$8,000.00
(c) Assistant Superintendent of Service (payable out of the General Fund)	\$7,500.00	\$8,000.00

Section 3. That the yearly salary of the Superintendent of Parks shall be determined by the Mayor, but shall be not less than \$7,100.00 and not more than \$7,500.00 and shall be paid every two weeks out of the General Fund.

Section 4. That Blue Cross comprehensive coverage and Blue Shield preferred coverage shall be furnished free of charge to all the above employees, their spouses and unmarried children under 19 years of age residing at home, plus \$1,000.00 life insurance on each employee.

Section 5. That this ordinance is an emergency measure necessary to the daily operation of the various departments of the city government, and for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the city, and shall be in full force and effect on its passage and approval by the Mayor.
