

ORDINANCE NO. 31 -70

To appropriate money and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of \$3,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund and credited to Service Fund Account No. 408, and the sum of \$6,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund and credited to Service Fund Account No. 409.

Section 2. That the sum of \$2,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund and credited to Service Fund Account No. 4Y6.

Section 3. That the sum of \$3,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund and credited to Election Expense Account No. 1H5, and the sum of \$1,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund and credited to Legal Advertising Account No. 1I7.

Section 4. That the sum of \$7,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund and credited to Health Fund Account No. 3B2.

Section 5. That this ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that there is insufficient money in the above accounts to pay existing bills, and this ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect on its passage and approval by the Mayor.
