To permit salaried employees to be paid bi-weekly, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That from and after the first day of January, 1970 and until further action of Council, the salaries of the following appointive officials and employees shall be not more than as follows per year:

(a) Superintendent of Streets and Buildings	\$10,200.00
(b) Superintendent of Maintenance	7,800.00
(c) Superintendent of Water	9,000.00
(d) Assistant Superintendent of Streets and Buildings	7,140.00
(e) Superintendent of Parks (Payable out of Service Fund)	6,600.00
(f) Custodian of Jeffrey Property (Payable out of General Fund)	5,700.00
(g) Custodian of Municipal Building	5,280.00
(h) Bookkeeper	4,800.00
(i) Secretary to Mayor and Auditor	5,196.00
(j) Secretary to Water Department	4,500.00
(k) Secretary to Building Department	5,196.00

Section 2. That Blue Cross comprehensive coverage and Blue Shield preferred coverage shall be furnished free of charge to all the above employees, their spouses and unmarried children under 19 years of age residing at home, plus \$1,000.00 life insurance on each employee.

Section 3. That Ordinance No. 42-68 is hereby repealed.

Section 4. That this ordinance is an emergency measure necessary in the daily operation of the various departments of the city government, and for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the city, and shall be in full force and effect on its passage and approval by the Mayor.
