

ORDINANCE NO. 37 -70

To authorize payment of a weeks salary to William Burdette in lieu of his vacation, and to declare an emergency.

BY IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That William Burdette be paid a weeks salary in lieu of one week of his 1970 vacation which he was unable to take because of the work load, and that this ordinance be effective as of December 1, 1970.

Section 2. That this ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that said payment was promised for December 1, 1970, and therefore, this ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
