

ORDINANCE NO. 39 -70

To increase the salary of the City Solicitor, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the salary of the City Solicitor is hereby increased to Fifty-seven Hundred (\$5,700.00) Dollars per year, commencing January 1, 1971 in accordance with Section 42 of the Charter giving Council the duty to fix his compensation.

Section 2. That Blue Cross Comprehensive Coverage and Blue Shield Preferred Coverage shall be furnished free of charge for himself, his wife and unmarried children under nineteen (19) years of age residing at home.

Section 3. That this ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that this ordinance must be effective before January 1, 1971 in order to become effective during the next term of office, and this ordinance shall go into force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
