

ORDINANCE NO. 40-70

To appropriate money, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of \$20,074.23 is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund and credited to the Police Fund.

Section 2. That the sum of \$5,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund and credited to Parks Account No. 15 B 1.

Section 3. That the sum of \$2,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered Water Fund and credited to Account No. 6 A 1.

Section 4. That the sum of \$1,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered Water Fund and credited to Account No. 6 B 1.

Section 5. That the sum of \$3,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered Water Fund and credited to Account No. 6 F 1.

Section 6. That the sum of \$900.00 is hereby appropriated from the State Highway Fund and credited to Account No. 11 A 6.

Section 7. That the sum of \$1,300.00 is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund and credited to Mayor's Account No. 1 C 6.

Section 8. That the sum of \$3,525.32 is hereby appropriated from the Police Pension Fund, which amount represents payments to the State of Ohio.

Section 9. That the sum of \$27,500.00 is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered Sewer Fund and credited to Sewer Fund Account No. 4 T 10.

Section 10. That this ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being there is insufficient money in the above accounts to pay existing obligations, and this ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect on its passage and approval by the Mayor.
