

ORDINANCE NO. 4-71

To appropriate money for the Recreation Activities Fund for the year 1971, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of \$500.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund to be deposited in the checking account known as the Recreation Activities Fund, which is used to pay for supplies, equipment and activities purchased or contracted for by the Recreation Department when such Recreation Department expects the cost of such supplies, equipment and activities to be reimbursed by the persons using the same or participating therein.

Section 2. That this ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that funds are needed in said Recreation Activities Fund and this ordinance shall go into force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
