WHEREAS, the Mid-Ohio Regional Planning Commission has created the Regional Comprehensive Plan in accordance with Sec. 713.23, Ohio R.C., and

WHEREAS, a complete copy of the Regional Comprehensive Plan has been certified to the planning commission of each municipal corporation in the region and to the Board of Commissioners of Franklin County in accordance with Section 713.24 of the Ohio R.C., and

WHEREAS, a formal presentation of the Comprehensive Plan has been made to the City of Bexley by the staff of the Mid-Ohio Regional Planning Commission, and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Planning Commission and the legislative authority of the City of Bexley to adopt the concept of the Comprehensive Plan as a set of guidelines to be used in cases where there is no conflict with local regulations,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Bexley:

Section 1. The Comprehensive Regional Plan, as certified to the Planning Commission of each municipality and the Board of Commissioners of Franklin County, is hereby adopted as a concept for the orderly growth of the region.

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
