

ORDINANCE NO. 6-71

To provide for the construction of a relief sanitary sewer at Parkview Avenue and Main Street, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be, and they hereby are authorized and directed to enter into a contract for the construction of a relief sanitary sewer at Parkview Avenue and Main Street. Plans and specifications for the same are to be approved by the Mayor and City Engineer before advertisement, and placed on file in the office of the Mayor.

Section 2. That said contract shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law.

Section 3. That this ordinance is an emergency ordinance, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, by reason of the necessity for immediate action, and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect upon passage thereof and approval by the Mayor.
