

ORDINANCE NO. 13 -71

To authorize the Mayor to enter into a contract for the purchase of a used police cruiser at an auction open to the public, and to declare an emergency,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor be and he hereby is authorized to enter into a contract, without advertising and bidding, for the purchase of a used police cruiser, at an auction open to the public, that the maximum amount that he may bid as the purchase price for such used police cruiser is \$1,500.00.

Section 2. That this ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that the city is without the necessary number of operating police cruisers, and this ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
