

ORDINANCE NO. 25-71

Providing for the purchase of two Police Cruisers for the use of the Police Department, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be and they are hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase of two new 1972 model 4 door sedans, standard size, for use as police cruisers, the specifications for which are on file in the Mayor's office, with the option of trading in on said cruisers a 1966 Chevrolet 2 door sedan, or a 1967 Ford Sedan, or both.

Section 2. Said contract shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law. The sum of \$6,600.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund for the purchase aforesaid.

Section 3. That Ordinance No. 24-71 passed September 28, 1971 is hereby repealed.

Section 4. This ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that the present cruisers are old and may become inoperable at any time, and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
