To provide a curfew for minors within the city and to make their parents responsible.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. No minor, under the age of twelve (12) years shall loiter, idle, wander, stroll or play in or upon the public streets or other public places or upon private property, except upon private property where the minor resides and with the permission of his parent or guardian, during the period between 10:00 P.M. to 5:30 A.M., unless accompanied by his parent, guardian or other adult person having the care and custody of the minor or unless such minor is on an emergency errand directed by his parent or guardian, or on legitimate business directed by his parent, guardian or other adult person having the care and custody of the minor.

Section 2. No minor, under the age of eighteen (18) years shall loiter, idle, wander, stroll or play in or upon the public streets or other public places or upon private property, except upon private property where the minor resides and with the permission of his parent or guardian, during the period between 11:00 P.M. to 4:30 A.M., unless accompanied by his parent, guardian or other adult person having the care and custody of the minor or unless such minor is on an emergency errand directed by his parent or guardian, or on legitimate business directed by his parent, guardian or other adult person having the care and custody of the minor.

Section 3. The parent, guardian or person having the care, custody or control of any minor violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor.

Section 4. No person shall aid, abet, influence or encourage any child under the age of eighteen (18) years to:

- (a) Violate Section 1 of this ordinance, or
- (b) Violate Section 2 of this ordinance, or
- (c) Be truant from home when such child has been reported as truant from home to the police or a municipal official, or
- (d) Be truant from school when the laws of this state require such child's attendance in school.

Section 5. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine not to exceed Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars and shall pay the costs of prosecution.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
