

ORDINANCE NO. 13-72

Providing for the purchase of a dump truck, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be, and they are hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase of one new current model dump truck with a rated capacity of not less than 21,000 G. V. W., complete with standard equipment; the Wheelbase of the vehicle shall be at least 149" - cab to axle 84", dual rear wheels (mud grip tires); the engine shall be a V-8 with a minimum displacement of 302 cu. in.; the clutch shall be 12" heavy duty; the transmission shall be four speed with power take-off opening; the front axle - 7000 lbs., the rear axle - 15,000 lbs.; front springs - 4500 lbs. each, rear springs - 10,400 lbs. each; helpers - 2000 lbs. each; the electrical system shall have battery - 70 amp., Alternator - 42 amp., minimum; the color to be Green - selected by the City of Bexley; the tires to be 8.25 x 20, 10 ply nylon, front and rear (mud grip on rear), with spare wheel; there shall be two-speed electric windshield wipers; fresh air heater and defroster; 2 West Coast mirrors.

Section 2. Said contract shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law. The sum of ~~\$1,250.00~~^{\$4,200.00} is hereby appropriated from the ~~Water~~ ^{GENERAL} Fund, and the sum of \$1,250.00 is hereby appropriated from the Sewer Fund for the purpose aforesaid.

Section 3. This ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that the present equipment is old and may become inoperable at any time, and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
