

ORDINANCE NO. 14 -72

Providing for the purchase of one pickup truck, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be, and they are hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase of a current model 1/2 ton pickup truck, 8 ft. Flareside or Stepside body, complete with standard equipment; the engine shall be at least 302 cu. in. V-8 gasoline powered unit; the transmission shall be automatic; front and rear springs - heavy duty; the electrical system shall have 38 amp. Alternator and I. C. C. Flasher; (5) Tires 8.15 x 15, 4 ply (mud and snow rear tires or equal); the color shall be Green, to be selected by the City of Bexley; there shall be Jr. West Coast Mirrors - 7-1/2 x 10-1/2 (left and right hand); Arm rests (right and left); deluxe fresh air heater; spare wheel; padded visors; padded dash; mechanical jack; deluxe seat belts with retractors; two speed electric windshield wipers, and windshield washer; seats - heavy duty; rear bumper - heavy duty, step type.

Section 2. Said contract shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law. The sum of \$1750.00 is hereby appropriated from the Street Fund and the sum of \$1750.00 is hereby appropriated from the Sewer Fund for the purpose aforesaid.

Section 3. This ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that the present equipment is old and may become inoperable at any time, and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
