

ORDINANCE NO. 18 -72

Providing for the purchase of group life insurance, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be and they hereby are authorized to enter into a contract, effective July 1, 1972, for the purchase of group life insurance in the amount of \$5,000.00 for each employee of the City except elected officials, the Health Commissioner and the City Solicitor, except that the amount of insurance furnished any employee over sixty-five (65) shall not exceed \$1,000.00.

Section 2. Said contract shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law.

Section 3. That this ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that the insurance will be effective July 1, 1972 and this ordinance shall go into force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
