

ORDINANCE NO. 19-72

To establish a schedule of fees to be charged with applications for zoning certificates, variances and rezoning under the provisions of Ordinance No. 8-72, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That a fee will be charged when an application is filed for a zoning certificate, as follows:

- A. For principal use \$25.00
- B. All other (garages, room additions, etc.) \$15.00
EXCLUDING FENCES

Section 2. That a fee will be charged when an application is filed for a variance, as follows:

- A. Single family \$15.00
- B. All others \$50.00

Section 3. That a fee will be charged when an application is filed for rezoning, as follows:

- A. First acre or any part thereof \$200.00
- B. Each additional acre, or portion \$25.00

Section 4. That this ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that said zoning ordinance is in effect and no charges have been provided for it, and this ordinance shall go into force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
