

ORDINANCE NO. 24-72

To provide for the Renovation of the Outdoor Terrace by replacing concrete deck, east steps and ramp, at the Jeffrey Mansion, 165 N. Parkview Avenue, Bexley, Ohio, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and the Auditor be and they hereby are authorized to enter into a contract, after advertising and bidding according to law, for the Renovation of the Outdoor Terrace by replacing concrete deck, east steps, and ramp at the Jeffrey Mansion, 165 N. Parkview Avenue, Bexley, Ohio, in accordance with specifications now on file in the office of the Service Department.

Section 2. Said contract shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law.

Section 3. That this ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that the Jeffrey Mansion is in need of immediate work, and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
