

ORDINANCE NO. 30-72

To repeal Ordinance No. 16-72 and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 16-72 passed July 11, 1972, consenting to the improvement of College Avenue between Livingston Avenue and Main Street in the corporate limits of the City of Bexley, by the Director of Highways in accordance with plans, specifications and estimates as approved by the Director and consenting that funds provided for by amended Senate Bill No. 428, passed by the 108th General Assembly of Ohio, be used to finance said improvement in accordance with the provisions of Ohio Department of Highways "Procedure Manual, State Issue I Funds", which ordinance also contains other provisions, is hereby repealed.

Section 2. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure by reason of the need for expediting highway improvements to promote highway safety and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected to council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor, otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
