

ORDINANCE NO. 33-72

Providing for the purchase of two Police Cruisers for the use of the Police Department.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be and they are hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase of two new 1973 sedans, standard size, for use as police cruisers, the specifications for which are on file in the Mayor's office, with the option of trading in on said cruisers a 1967 Ford 2-door sedan or a 1970 Chevrolet sedan, or both.

Section 2. That said contract shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law. The sum of \$7,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund for the purchase aforesaid.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
