

ORDINANCE NO. 36-72

To establish a Refuse Fund to be used as a fund for garbage and refuse collection and all activities related thereto as set forth and described in Ordinance No. 29-70.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Auditor be and he hereby is authorized and directed to open an account which shall be known as the Refuse Fund and which shall be used to pay for supplies, equipment, personnel and other expenses necessary for the proper collection and disposal of garbage, trash, brush, leaves and other refuse.

Section 2. That on December 31, 1972 all monies collected for garbage and refuse collection pursuant to Ordinance No. 29-70 less all expenses attributable to such garbage and refuse collection and disposal from October 1, 1970 to and including December 31, 1972 shall be transferred from the General Fund into this Refuse Fund.

Section 3. That this ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the proper operation of the garbage and refuse collection and disposal department, and the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the city, and shall be in full force and effect on its passage and approval by the Mayor.
