

ORDINANCE NO. 40-72

To appropriate money from the various Unencumbered Funds and to reappropriate moneys within the various Funds for the current operations of the several governmental departments as herein specified and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:






