

ORDINANCE NO. 7 -73

Providing for the purchase of an accounting machine, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and the Auditor be and they hereby are authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase of an accounting machine with either one of the following specifications:

- (a) A posting system or machine capable of recording charges and receipts separately and as a total for:

Water  
Sewer  
Refuse  
Penalties  
Miscellaneous

on Journal, Ledger and actual bills, together with proper locks and date slugs.

- (b) A system or machine similar in every respect to the above which, in addition, will be capable of handling all entries necessary to properly record information connected with imposing an Income Tax upon the citizens.

Section 2. Said contract shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law.

Section 3. This ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that the Water Department is in urgent need of an accounting machine, and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
