

ORDINANCE NO. 8 -73

To amend Ordinance No. 19-69, Section 74 which controls the operation of bicycles, Section 76 which controls riding bicycles and Section 77 which provides for signal devices, lights and reflectors on bicycles.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 19-69, Section 74 is hereby amended by the addition of a new paragraph (d) as follows:

(d) No parent of any child or guardian of any ward shall authorize or knowingly permit any such child or ward to violate any of the provisions of this ordinance.

Section 2. That Ordinance No. 19-69, Section 76 is hereby amended by the addition of new paragraphs (b), (c) and (d) as follows:

(b) No person shall operate a bicycle at speed greater than is reasonable and prudent under the conditions then existing.

(c) No person operating a bicycle shall carry any package, bundle or article which prevents the rider from keeping at least one hand on the handle bar.

(d) No person shall park a bicycle upon a street other than on the roadway against the curb or upon the sidewalk in a rack to support the bicycle, or against a building or at the curb, in such a manner as to afford the least obstruction to pedestrian traffic.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
