

ORDINANCE NO. 15-73

To authorize the purchase of new radio equipment for the Police Department, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be, and they hereby are authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase of a new base radio station (repeater base and duplexer) which will be installed in the present console, transmitter cable and brackets, two conversion modules to transmit and receive, two monitor units to receive County and Statewide frequencies, including the labor to convert the console, the labor to hook up the modules and monitor units and the labor to install the base station and antennae system, the plans and specifications for which are on file in the office of the Safety Director.

Section 2. That said contract shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law, and the sum of \$5,500.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund.

Section 3. This ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the present equipment is becoming obsolete and may become inoperable at any time, and this ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
