

ORDINANCE NO. 22 -73

To appropriate funds, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of \$32,775.00 is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered Water Fund for the purpose of paying to the State of Ohio the cost of the water line which will be installed as part of the improvement of Clifton Avenue from Aium Creek Bridge eastward to Drexel Avenue, by the State of Ohio, the contract for which provides that our share will be adjusted when the final actual cost and allocations are determined, but also provides that we must deposit the estimated amount of \$32,775.00 immediately.

Section 2. That this ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that the State of Ohio has advised us that in order for said project to be completed it must receive the money by July 12, 1973, and this ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
