

ORDINANCE NO. 23 -73

To appropriate monies from the Water Fund for the purpose of paying for accessories to the Burroughs Accounting System not previously contemplated.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of One Thousand Four Hundred Ninety Nine Dollars and Fourteen cents (\$1,499.14) be appropriated from the Water Fund for the purpose of paying for a Tape Perforator for the new accounting equipment.

Section 2. That the sum of One Thousand Three Hundred Sixty Dollars and Fourteen Cents (\$1,360.14) be appropriated from the Water Fund to pay for a Tape Reader for the new accounting equipment.

Section 3. That the sum of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) be appropriated from the Water Fund to pay for the cost of filing cabinets for proper storage of records and accounts.

Section 4. That the sum of Six Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$650.00) be appropriated from the Water Fund for the purpose of paying for paper, printing, old record storage, and miscellaneous accessories for the new accounting system.

Section 5. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
