


ORDINANCE NO. 3-74

Authorizing the purchase of materials for the maintenance and repair of streets for the balance of the year 1974 and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be and they are hereby authorized after advertisement according to law to enter into contracts for the purchase and delivery of the following materials for the maintenance and repair of the various streets and avenues in the City of Bexley for the balance of the year, 1974, to-wit:

Bituminous Concrete


Approximate Quantity - 1,200 Tons

Cement Concrete


Approximate Quantity - 800 Cu. Yds.

Section 2. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that the city needs the material for the immediate maintenance and repair of various streets, and the said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor.
