

RESOLUTION NO. 6 -74

Whereas Section 28A of the Charter of the City of Bexley, Ohio, permits the transfer of excess money not necessary for the operation of the water fund from the water fund to the general fund providing certain conditions established in said section are in effect; and

Whereas, said conditions are now in effect and there is such excess money in the water fund; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Auditor is hereby authorized and directed to transfer Twenty Thousand (\$20,000.00) Dollars from the water fund to the general fund, it having been represented to this Council that said sum is not necessary for the operation of the water fund, that such transfer has been approved by the Mayor and the Auditor, that this city is buying its water from the City of Columbus, Ohio, and the ratio between the water rates charged by the cities of Columbus, Ohio and Bexley, Ohio remains smaller than it was on July 1, 1955.

Section 2. That this resolution shall be effective upon its approval by the Mayor.
