

ORDINANCE NO. 14 -74

Providing for the purchase of two Police Cruisers for the use of the Police Department, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be and they are hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase of two new 1975 sedans, for use as police cruisers, the specifications for which are on file in the Mayor's office, with the option of trading in on said cruisers a 1968 Chevrolet Four Door sedan or a 1970 Chevrolet sedan, or both.

Section 2. That said contract shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law. The sum of \$3,500.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund for the purchase aforesaid.



That this ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that the existing cruisers are nearing the end of their usefulness and it is necessary to replace them as soon as possible and this ordinance shall go into force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
