

ORDINANCE NO. 25-74

To appropriate money from the various Unencumbered Funds and to reappropriate moneys within the various Funds for the current operations of the several governmental Departments as herein specified and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the following sums be appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund and credited to:

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Section 4. That the following sums be appropriated from the unencumbered Street Fund and credited to:

Section 5. That the following sums be appropriated from the unencumbered Water Fund and credited to:


(a) Water Distribution .		\$30,400.00
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Section 6. That the following sums be appropriated from the unencumbered Sewer Fund and credited to:


(a) Sewer	Personal Services	\$3,500.00
