

ORDINANCE NO. 26 -74

To establish a Recreation Fund, to transfer the balance in the Recreation Activities Fund into the Recreation Fund, to discontinue the Recreation Activities Fund and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the auditor be, and he hereby is, authorized and directed to open a checking account which will be known as the Recreation Fund and which will be used to pay the salaries, equipment, maintenance and repairs, wages, fees for professional instruction, supplies and other materials and other activities and programs of the Recreation Department.

Section 2. That the Recreation Activities Fund is hereby discontinued as of December 31, 1974, and any balance in said fund shall be transferred to the Recreation Fund and Ordinance No. 19-70 creating the Recreation Activities Fund is hereby repealed as of December 31, 1974.

Section 3. That commencing January 1, 1975 all charges and fees collected by the Recreation Department shall be deposited in the Recreation Fund.

Section 4. That this ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that it is necessary to establish said fund for operation commencing January 1, 1975, and this ordinance shall go into force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
