RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A COOPERATION AGREEMENT WITH THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF FRANK-LIN COUNTY, OHIO PURSUANT TO THE HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT ACT OF 1974 (PUBLIC LAW 93-383, 42 U.S.C. 5301)
WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Franklin County and the Cry of BEXLEY desire to undertake jointly planning and administrative activities essential to the preparation of an application for urban county entitlement funds and implementation of programs pursuant to the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 (P.L. 93-383, 42 U.S.C. 5301); and
WHEREAS, the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 (herafter referrred to as the Act) provides for entitlement grants to urban counties; and
WHEREAS, Franklin County will be an eligible applicant for such a grant upon fulfilling criteria specified in the Rules and Regulations for Community Development Block Grants; and
WHEREAS, the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development, on February 27, 1975, made preliminary recognition for the purposes of qualifying Franklin County as an urban county under Section 102(a)(6) of the Act and Section 570.105, and whereas official designation as an urban county is dependent upon final approval of cooperation agreements for units of government whose total population exceeds 200,000; and
WHEREAS, Let of Bexley is within the geographical boundaries of Frunklin County and wishes to join Franklin County in its urban county entitlement application as provided in Section 570. 105(b)(3)(III) of the Community Development Block Grant Rules and Regulations; now therefore
BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF the City of BEXLEY
Section 1. That the City of Bexley does hereby enter into a cooperation agreement with the Board of Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio to undertake planning and administrative activities preparation of applications for urban county entitlement funds and implementation of programs under the Act.

Section 2. That MAYOR is hereby authorized and directed to execute the cooperation agreement with the Board of Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio which is attached hereto.

Section 3. This resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of DEXLEY and therefore, shall become effective immediately upon passage. The reason for the emergency is that the time period for submission of the cooperation agreement to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development expires April 15, 1975, and the funds available under the Act are urgently needed for housing assistance and community development activities.

# COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT COOPERATION AGREEMENT FOR GRANT

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Franklin County and the City of Bexley desire to undertake jointly planning and administrative activities essential to the preparation of an application for urban county entitlement funds and implementation of programs pursuant to the Housing and Community Development Act (P.L. 93-383, 42 U.S.C. 5301); and

WHEREAS, the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 (hereafter referred to as the Act) provides for entitlement grants to urban counties; and

WHEREAS, Franklin County will be an eligible applicant for such a grant upon fulfilling criteria specified in the Rules and Regulations for Community Development Block Grants; and

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development, on February 27, 1975, made preliminary recognition for the purposes of qualifying Franklin County as an urban county under Section 102 (a)(6) of the Act and Section 570.105, and whereas official designation as an urban county is dependent upon final approval of cooperation agreements for units of government whose total population exceeds 200,000; and

WHEREAS, to City of BexLey is within the geographical boundaries of Franklin County and wishes to join Franklin County in its urban county entitlement application under Section 570.300 and as provided in Section 570.105(b)(3)(III) of the Community Development Block Grant Rules and Regulations; now therefore it is hereby agreed:

- Section 1. That Franklin County and The City of Bexcey will cooperate in undertaking, or assisting in undertaking, essential community development and housing assistance activities, specifically urban renewal and publicly assisted housing, and other essential activities during the first program year of the urban county community development process.
- That Franklin County, or its agent, shall prepare the local portion of the county-wide community development plan, program and budget and a housing assistance plan based upon information as to needs, objectives, plans, and programs supplied by the of the officer of the county assumes full responsibility and all obligations as the applicant including, but not limited to, the analysis of needs; setting of objectives; development of plans, programs and budgets; and furnishing assurances and certifications.

- Section 3. That Franklin County, or its agent, shall concurrently prepare the county-wide community development plan, program, and budget and housing assistance plan, utilizing input from local planning activities, and shall prepare and submit the urban county entitlement application, and assume all related responsibilities, as the applicant.
- That the county-wide community development plan and program and housing assistance plan and later amendments thereto, shall be binding on both the City of Bexcey and Franklin County for the program year, which ends twelve months after approval by HUD, or until the program is completed and extended, whichever is later.
- Section 5. That the Mid-Ohio Regional Planning Commission is authorized to act as the agent of Franklin County in planning, administration, and overall coordination of the urban county community development process.
- Section 6. That the City of Bexee hereby authorizes disbursement of funds for the preparation of a community development application and related planning activities (not to exceed ten percent of the urban county entitles ment grant) to be reimbursed from entitlement funds contingent upon a wait ability of funds and timely submission of the urban county applications.
- In implementing plans and carrying out essential community development and housing activities, in conformance with the plans; the OF BEXLEY will be the implementing agency where convenient or necessary under Ohio law, but the County shall retain full responsibility and all obligations as the applicant under the statute.
