Providing for the resurfacing and repairing of certain streets, curbs and gutters, in the City of Bexley, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That, whereas, the following streets, to-wit:

1. Cassingham Road, from Main Street to Livingston Avenue;
2. Parkview Avenue, from Broad Street to Clifton Avenue;
3. Remington Road, from Main Street to Fair Avenue;

are in need of repair so that the same may be maintained as proper highways, said streets shall be repaired by resurfacing the same with asphaltic concrete, and repairing the base and the curbs and gutters thereof, in accordance with the plans specifications, estimates and profiles thereof heretofore to be prepared by the engineers and to be on file in the Office of the Mayor.

Section 2. That the entire cost of said repairs shall be paid by the City.

Section 3. That the Mayor and Auditor be and they are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract or contracts for said repairs after advertisement according to law.

Section 4. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that said streets are fast deteriorating and becoming unsafe for traffic, and this ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect upon passage thereof and approval by the Mayor.
