RESOLUTION IN FAVOR OF THE CENTRAL OHIO TRANSIT AUTHORITY
PROPOSED TAX LEVY RENEWAL.

WHEREAS, the Central Ohio Transit Authority (COTA) promised to keep the buses running throughout the Columbus metropolitan area and to make route and bus improvements; and

WHEREAS, COTA promised to give senior citizens a fare reduction, to keep the fare at 50¢, and to make the fare the same everywhere, all of which has been done, and,

WHEREAS, COTA has increased route miles 75%, increased ridership almost 1,000,000 the first year, set up seven Park'n Ride sites, initiated express routes downtown, and purchased 31 new buses, and


WHEREAS, COTA has proposed and needs the continuation of the 8/10 mill levy, which does not involve a tax increase, and which renewal levy will keep COTA improving on a long range schedule and will provide funds to make COTA eligible for Federal and State matching funds,

NOW THEREFORE, Be It resolved by the Council of the City of Bexley, Ohio:

Section 1. That the Council of the City of Bexley does hereby endorse and support the COTA Levy Renewal and urges the citizens of this community to join in such support by voting for the COTA Tax Levy Renewal, in order to "KEEP THE GREEN LIGHT ON FOR COTA".
