

RESOLUTION NO. 10 - 75

Authorizing the Mayor to execute a cooperation agreement with the Board of Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, pursuant to the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 (Public Law 93-383, 42 U.S.C. 5301).

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Franklin County and the City of Bexley desire to undertake jointly planning and administrative activities essential to the preparation of an application for urban county entitlement funds and implementation of programs pursuant to the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 (P. L. 93-383, 42 U.S.C. 5301); and

WHEREAS, the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 (hereafter referred to as the Act) provides for entitlement grants to urban counties; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bexley is within the geographical boundaries of Franklin County and has participated in the Community Development Program with Franklin County in fiscal year 1975 as provided in Section 570.105 b 3(III) of the Community Development Block Grant Rules and Regulations; and desires to renew and extend its contract so as to participate in the program in fiscal year 1976;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY:

Section 1. That the City of Bexley does hereby enter into a cooperation agreement with the Board of Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, to undertake planning and administrative activities, preparation of applications for urban county entitlement funds and implementation of programs under the Act.

Section 2. That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute the renewal and extension of the cooperation agreement with the Board of Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, in substantially the same form as the previously executed contract for fiscal year 1975.
