

ORDINANCE NO. 14 -75

To authorize the employment of Langdon Bell to represent the city, to appropriate funds therefor and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to employ Langdon Bell to represent the City in the pending hearing before the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio with regard to the Columbia Gas application for a rate increase with the provision that this is to be a joint representation with UPPER Arlington, Gahanna, Westerville and Grandview Heights and the fee will be apportioned prorata, based on the population of each municipality.

Section 2. That there is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of One Thousand Dollars to pay for said services.

Section 3. That this ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that hearings are pending and immediate action is needed to protect the interest of the City, and this ordinance shall go into force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
