

ORDINANCE NO. 24 -75

To authorize the resurfacing of the streets north of Fair Avenue and south of Broad Street between Cassady Avenue and Dawson Avenue; and Caroline Avenue between Parkview Avenue and Cassady Avenue; using the Slurry seal process, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be, and they hereby are authorized to enter into a contract for resurfacing various streets, in the city, using the Slurry seal process, the specifications for which are on file in the office of the Mayor, which said streets are as follows:

Plymouth Avenue, Cassady to Dawson;
Dale Avenue, Cassady to Dawson;
Elm Avenue, Cassady to Dawson;
Powell Avenue, Cassady to Dawson;
Seneca Park Place, Cassady to Dawson;
Bexford Place, Cassady to Dawson;
Bullit Park Place, Bexford to Broad;
Caroline Avenue, Parkview to Cassady.

Section 2. That the contract shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law.

Section 3. That the sum of \$7,000.00 is hereby appropriated to cover the cost of the same.

Section 4. That this ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that said streets are hazardous and need resurfacing, and this ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
