RESOLUTION OF COUNCIL PROPOSING TO COOPERATE WITH THE DIRECTOR OF TRANSPORTATION IN PAVEMENT MARKING PROGRAM

RESOLUTION NO. 1 - 75

Mrs. Wood moved the adoption of the following resolution:

WHEREAS, the public interest demands the improvement hereinafter described.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of City of Bexley, State of Ohio, hereinafter referred to as the Municipality, that:

SECTION 1.

The public interest demands the improvement, under the provisions of Chapter 5521 of the Ohio Revised Code and Section 205 of the 1973 National Federal-aid Highway Act, of all nonstandard pavement markings on roads and streets under the jurisdiction of the Municipality of Bexley, State of Ohio.

SECTION 2.

The Municipality does hereby agree to cooperate with the Director of Transportation in said improvement(s) by providing all information and accident data as necessary to evaluate the improvement(s) as required by said act.

SECTION 3.

Mr. Madison is hereby empowered and directed on behalf of the Council officials therein to enter into agreements with the Director of Transportation as necessary to complete the planning and construction of this improvement.
