

ORDINANCE NO. 12-76

To grant a special permit to Alfred Tibor.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1: That Alfred Tibor is hereby granted permission to construct two brick entrance columns on city property in front of his residence at 525 N. Cassady Avenue, said columns to be 3 feet, 4 inches high and to be located approximately three feet from the sidewalk, providing the construction and location of the same are approved by the Bexley Board of Zoning Appeals.

Section 2: That this permission is granted on the condition that if the City of Bexley should ever decide that the interest of the City requires the removal of said columns, they shall be immediately removed by Mr. Tibor or the current owner of the property, at no cost to the City of Bexley.

Section 3: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
