

ORDINANCE NO. 13-76

To amend Ordinance No. 19-69 to add imprisonment to the penalty for Reckless Operation of a Motor Vehicle, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Section 34 of Ordinance 19-69 be amended by deleting existing paragraph (c) and enacting in lieu thereof the following:

- (c) Every person who is convicted of a violation of this section shall be punished by a fine of not more than Three Hundred (\$300.00) Dollars, or imprisoned in the County Jail for not more than 30 days, or both, together with the costs of prosecution.

Section 2. That this ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that it is necessary to increase the penalty for the proper and effective enforcement of the law, and this ordinance shall go into force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
