

ORDINANCE NO. 16-76

To provide for the submission to the electors of the City of Bexley, Ohio, of an amendment to the Charter of the City of Bexley which would delete the Engineer from membership on the Planning Commission and provide for his replacement by an additional citizen.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO,

two-thirds of all members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the question of the amendment of the charter of the City of Bexley, by the amendment of Section 56, be submitted to a vote of the qualified electors of the city at a special election to be held on June 8, 1976, at the regular places of voting in said city between the hours of 6:30 A.M. and 7:30 P.M., said amended Section 56 to read as follows:

"Section 56. The city Planning Commission shall consist of the Mayor and four citizens of the city who shall serve without compensation and who, with the concurrence of Council, shall be appointed by the Mayor for terms of 48 months each commencing July 1, 1976, except that the terms of the members so appointed effective July 1, 1976, shall be adjusted so that one expires June 30, 1977, and each June 30 thereafter until each term is for 48 months."

Section 2. That the ballots for said election shall, at the top thereof, be entitled "City Charter Amendment Ballot" and the question to be submitted on said ballot shall be in the words following: "Shall the amendment to the Charter of the City of Bexley providing for the amendment of Section 56 be adopted?" To the left of said wording in boxes, with appropriate place for marking, shall appear the words "YES" and "NO", and each voter shall indicate his vote by making a crossmark with a black lead pencil in the place so provided. Where voting machines are used in the City of Bex-

ley, the ballot presentation shall be the same as used throughout Franklin County.

Section 3. That the Mayor be, and he is hereby, directed to give public notice of the time and place of holding such election by publication of such notice at least ten days prior to the day of such election, in a newspaper of general circulation in said city.

Section 4: That the clerk be, and he is hereby, directed to mail a copy of the proposed charter amendment to each elector whose name appears upon the registration books of the last general or regular election held in said city, at least thirty days before the date of such election.

Section 5. That the clerk be, and he is hereby, directed to certify a copy of this ordinance to the Board of Elections of Franklin County, Ohio.

Section 6. That to pay the cost of printing and mailing said copies of said proposed charter amendment and of publishing said notice, there be and is hereby, appropriated from the general fund the sum of \$1,000.00 or so much thereof as may be needed.

Section 7. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
