

ORDINANCE NO: 17-76

To provide for the submission to the electors of the City of Bexley, Ohio, an amendment to the Charter of the City of Bexley which would decrease the number of City employees who are exempt from Civil Service.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1: That the question of the amendment of the charter of the City of Bexley, by amending Section 51 (f) and Section 53, be submitted to a vote of the qualified electors of the city at a special election to be held on June 8, 1976, at the regular places of voting in said city between the hours of 6:30 A.M. and 7:30 P.M., as follows:

(a) That existing Section 51, paragraph (f) shall be amended to read as follows:

"(f) All employees whose service is temporary or part time"

(b) That existing Section 53, shall be amended to read as follows:

"Section 53. All persons whose positions were previously exempt from the provisions of former Section 51, paragraph (f) and whose positions are now within the provisions of Section 52, and who have been continuously in the service of the municipality since July 1, 1974, shall retain their positions until discharged, reduced, promoted or transferred in accordance with the provisions of Sections 50 to 55, inclusive."

Section 2: That the ballot for said election shall, at the top thereof, be entitled "City Charter Amendment Ballot" and the question to be submitted on said ballot shall be in the words following: "Shall the amendment to the Charter of the City of Bexley providing for the amendment of Section 51, paragraph (f) and Section 53 be adopted?" To the left of said wording in boxes, with an appropriate place for marking, shall appear the words "YES" and "NO", and each voter shall indicate his vote by making a crossmark with a black lead pencil in the place so provided. Where voting machines are used in the City of Bexley, the ballot presentation shall be the same as used throughout Franklin County.

Section 3: That the Mayor be, and he is hereby directed to give public notice of the time and place of holding such election, by publication of such notice at least ten days prior to the day of such election, in a newspaper of general circulation in said city.

Section 4: That the clerk be, and he hereby is directed to mail a copy of the proposed charter amendment to each elector whose name appears upon the registration books of the last general election or regular election held in said city, at least thirty days before the date of such election.

Section 5: That the clerk be, and he hereby is directed to certify a copy of this ordinance to the Board of Elections of Franklin County, Ohio.

Section 6: That to pay the cost of printing and mailing said copies of the proposed charter amendment and of publishing said notice, there is hereby

appropriated from the general fund the sum of \$500.00 or so much thereof as may be needed.

Section 7: That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
