

ORDINANCE NO 20-76

To establish a schedule of fees to be charged by the Planning Commission, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1: That the fees to be paid when applications are filed for hearings before the Bexley Planning Commission shall be as follows:

| B. Approval of plans | 100.00 |
| C. Split of lot or existing parcel | 25.00 |
| D. Replatting or new plat | 100.00 |
| E. Approval of exterior sign | 50.00 |

Section 2: If the Planning Commission decides it needs the services of an independant architect or planner to assist it, the commission shall designate the person to be consulted and the cost thereof shall be paid by the applicant in addition to the above filing fees.

Section 3: That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation to the public health, peace, safety, and welfare, for the reason that because of the moratorium the work of the Planning Commission has increased and it is necessary to properly charge for the same and this ordinance shall go into full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
