

ORDINANCE NO: 23 -76

Providing for the resurfacing and repairing of Cassingham Road, from Broad Street to Ruhl Avenue, in the City of Bexley, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1: That whereas, the following street, to-wit:

Cassingham Road, from Broad Street to Ruhl Avenue

is in need of repair so that the same may be maintained as a proper highway, said street shall be repaired by resurfacing it with bituminous concrete, and repairing the base and the curbs and gutters thereof, in accordance with the plans, specifications, estimates and profiles thereof heretofore prepared by the Assistant Service Director and on file in the Office of the Mayor.

Section 2: That the entire cost of said repairs shall be paid by the City.

Section 3: That the Mayor and Auditor be and they are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract for said repairs with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law.

Section 4: That Ordinance No. 10-76 is hereby repealed.

Section 5: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare for the reason that the condition of said street is dangerous to traffic, and this ordinance shall go into full force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
