

ORDINANCE NO. 29 -76

To authorize the Mayor and the Auditor to enter into contract for the replacement of sections of sidewalks at various locations in the City of Bexley, Ohio and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and the Auditor be and they hereby are authorized to enter into a contract, after advertising and bidding according to law, for the replacement of sections of sidewalks at various locations in the City of Bexley, Ohio, in accordance with specifications now on file in the office of the Service Department.

Section 2. Said contract shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law.

Section 3. That this ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that the sidewalks are in need of immediate work, and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
