

ORDINANCE NO. 36 -76

To permit the erection of a Speakers Platform at Drexel Avenue and Broad Street and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That permission is hereby given to the Bexley Bicentennial Committee to erect a Speakers Platform of brick, approximately twelve feet by eighteen feet, twelve inches high, in the northwest quadrant of the circle at Drexel Avenue and Broad Street, at no cost to the City.

Section 2. That this ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that the committee wants to complete construction before bad weather, and this ordinance shall go into immediate effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
