

ORDINANCE NO 40 -76

To provide additional legal counsel for the City of Bexley, authorizing the employment of assistants in connection with the prosecution of criminal and traffic cases in Municipal Court of Franklin County, Ohio, setting the compensation of said assistants, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That members of the legal staff of the office of the City Attorney of Columbus, Ohio, serving as prosecutors, be and hereby are employed for the purpose of representing the City of Bexley in criminal and traffic cases pending, or which in the future might be pending in the Franklin County Municipal Court, Columbus, Ohio.

Section 2. That said assistant City Attorneys provided for herein shall have and exercise the same powers as the Bexley City Solicitor in connection with the prosecution of criminal or traffic cases in the Franklin County Municipal Court, Columbus, Ohio.

Section 3. That the office of the City Attorney shall be paid the sum of Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars per hour for the services of prosecutors on behalf of the City of Bexley; that the Columbus City Prosecutor's office shall charge the City of Bexley on a case-by-case basis, and the City of Bexley shall pay the compensation provided for above to the Columbus City Attorney's office for deposit in the Treasury of the City of Columbus.

Section 4. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with the City of Columbus for the services outlined above, said contract to terminate December 31, 1977 unless otherwise terminated by either of the parties on thirty (30) days notice and to contain such other terms and conditions as may be acceptable to the Bexley City Solicitor.

Section 5. That this Ordinance be, and the same hereby is, declared an emergency measure necessary for the public safety and welfare of the City of Bexley, for the reason tha the City has an immediate need for the services of counsel in connection with the prosecution of criminal and traffic cases in the Franklin County Municipal Court, Columbus, Ohio, wherefore, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
